

IOSCO TOWNSHIP BOARD
REGULAR MEETING
MINUTES
OCTOBER 20th, 2016

Supervisor Miller called the meeting to order at 8:01PM. Treasurer Bonnville, Clerk Delmerico, Trustee Parker and Trustee DeGroot present. Also present was Zoning Administrator Allen, and Deputy Clerk Jenks, Additionally, Mr. Helzerman, Republican candidate for the 4th County Commission, and several Iosco Township residents: Jeff Matteson, Ken Wajda and his son.

After the Pledge of Allegiance, Delmerico made a Motion to approve the Agenda, seconded by DeGroot. All Ayes, Motion Carried. (AA, MC)

During the 1st Call to the Public Mr. Helzerman addressed the Board and asked their support in the upcoming election. Then Mr. Wajda asked how the internet project was coming. Parker and Delmerico explained that another post card survey should be going out around the end of the year to get residents thoughts about funding options.

Delmerico made a Motion to approve, with corrections, the Regular Meeting Minutes 9-15-2016. AA, MC. Delmerico then made a Motion to approve the Special Board Meeting Minutes of October 5th, 2016; seconded by DeGroot. AA, MC. Delmerico made a Motion to approve the Election Commission Meeting Minutes of 10-06-2016; seconded by Bonnville. AA, MC..

The Treasurer reported that as of today's date the was \$933,174.19 in various Township funds.

Delmerico made a Motion to pay \$127,846.68 in Township bills; seconded by Parker. Roll Call vote. AA, MC. This amount includes \$23,219.44 to Chloride Solutions for the final application of the summer dust control program, \$77,349.69 to the Livingston County Road Commission for township road work, and \$11,077.00 to Alchin's Disposal for the monthly trash pickup bill.

Trustee DeGroot submitted his resignation as the Township representative to the Fowlerville Fire Authority, effective immediately. He recommended that Treasurer Bonnville be appointed as his replacement. Parker made a Motion to accept his resignation; seconded by Bonnville. AA, MC. After a short discussion, the Board acted upon his suggestion as DeGroot made a Motion to appoint Bonnville as the Township's Fowlerville Fire Authority's Board Representative. AA, MC.

Parker reported that the Planning Commission is still working on the Medical Marijuana Ordinance (MMO), or section of the Zoning Ordinance, currently it is at the Township's Attorney for review. The State has recently passed some laws concerning the MMO, and revisions to the current proposed material may have to be done.

Delmerico made a Motion to approve the revised Zoning Ordinance; seconded by Parker. AA, MC. The Clerk will publish notice of the passing and effective date in the

Fowlerville News and Views, the Township's paper of record.

Parker also reported that the Zoning Board of Appeals had met and approved the application for a variance.

The Zoning Administrator, Ms. Allen, presented her report to the Board. As of this date the Township has issued 30 Zoning Compliance Certificates, of which 5 were for dwellings, and 14 waivers of the same. She submitted the paperwork for a 1 year extension for the Ketchel Temporary Housing permit. Delmerico made a Motion to approve the extension, along with waiving the extension fee. Parker seconded the Motion. AA, MC.

She has also sent a letter to Mr. McKay, as directed by the Board at last month's meeting, outlining the Board's concerns about him being on the verge of violating zoning ordinance provisions concerning his home occupation: NoBull Strength & Performance Training.

Delmerico made a Motion to approve the rate of 150% of the Federal Poverty Income Guidelines for 2017 for property tax relief. Bonnville seconded the Motion. Roll Call vote, AA, MC.

Delmerico made a Motion to increase the Precinct Election Chair Wage to \$15.00 per hour. Bonnville seconded the Motion. Roll Call vote, AA, MC.

The Board tabled Internet Mailing to November meeting.

After discussion, Delmerico made a Motion to buy Microsoft 365 for the Deputy Clerk computer. Parker seconded the Motion. Price will be \$100.0 per computer. Parker seconded the Motion. Roll Call vote. AA, MC.

Delmerico made a Motion to purchase Microsoft Office for the Clerk's computer for a price not to exceed \$500.00; seconded by DeGroot. Roll Call vote. AA, MC.

The Treasurer would like to purchase some new tables using the money in the Hall rental account. She will research prices and report back to Board at the November meeting.

There was no response to the 2nd Call to the Public

Delmerico made a Motion to Adjourn at 9:07PM; seconded by Bonnville. AA, MC.
