

IOSCO TOWNSHIP BOARD
REGULAR MEETING
MINUTES
NOVEMBER 17th, 2016

Supervisor Miller called the meeting to order with the Pledge of Allegiance at 8:03PM. Clerk Delmerico, Treasurer Bonnville, Trustee DeGroot, Trustee Parker present. Also attending the meeting was Anne Allen, Township Assessor & Zoning Administrator, Kailey Jenks, Doug Helzerman, and Alex Allen-Boy Scout.

Delmerico made a Motion to approve the Agenda, seconded by Parker. All Ayes, Motion Carried. (AA, MC)

1st Call to the Public: Mr. Helzerman introduced himself as the new 4th District County Commissioner. Alex Allen introduced himself. He is working on his Eagle Scout Badge, and is attending the meeting as part of his Merit Badge requirements..

Delmerico made a Motion to adopt the proposed Regular Meeting Minutes of 10-20-2016; as corrected. Parker seconded the Motion. AA, MC.

The Treasurer reported that as of this date, there was \$720,383.10 in the General Fund checking account, \$201,613.47 in the Certificate of Deposit, and \$18,208.56 in various small Township accounts.

Bonnville made a Motion to pay \$29,455.17 in Township bills, seconded by DeGroot. Roll Call vote, AA, MC.

Bonnville said that there was to be a Fowlerville Fire Authority meeting on November 22nd, and that she would have a report of it at the December Board meeting.

Parker reported that the Planning Commission (PC) would be covering the Medical Marijuana Ordinance (or Special Use Article of the Zoning Ordinance) at their December meeting. The PC has invited the Fowlerville Police Chief, and State Representative Henry Vaupel to the meeting to explain new laws concerning medical marijuana. After a discussion it was decided to ask the Township Attorney to attend the meeting; along with a representative of LawNet-Narcotics Enforcement.

Ms. Allen reported that she has issued 4 Zoning Compliance Certificates (ZCC) for the month, 2 of which were for new dwellings, and 1 a renewal of an existing certificate for construction of a new dwelling. She also issued a Wavier for a ZCC.

After a short discussion, Delmerico made a Motion to purchase a new Fax Machine from Staples for a price not to exceed \$125.00; seconded by Miller. Roll Call vote, AA, MC.

Bonnville made a Motion to authorize her to sign the contracts with the Howell, Fowlerville, and LESA School Districts to collect their summer taxes, at a rate of \$3.00 per parcel. Parker seconded the Motion. Roll Call vote, AA, MC.

Miller thanked DeGroot for his decades of service to the Township, serving as a Trustee.

There was no response to the 2nd Call to the Public.

Delmerico made a Motion to Adjourn at 9:00PM; seconded by Parker. AA, MC.
