

IOSCO TOWNSHIP BOARD
REGULAR MEETING
MINUTES
NOVEMBER 16th, 2017

Supervisor Miller called the meeting to order, at 8:00PM, with the Pledge of Allegiance. Treasurer Bonnville, Clerk Delmerico, Trustees Parker and VanHouten present. Also present was Zoning Administrator/Assessor Allen, and County Commissioner Helzerman.

Delmerico made a Motion to approve the Agenda with addition; seconded by Parker. All Ayes, Motion Carried. (AA, MC)

Call to the Public: Commissioner Helzerman reported on County activities. The Budget has been passed for the upcoming fiscal year, the County has joined SPARK, a regional economic development organization, the County met with representatives of the Rover/ET pipeline project.

Delmerico made a Motion to adopt the proposed Regular Meeting Minutes of 10-19-2017; with corrections, with Bonnville seconding the Motion. AA, MC..

The Treasurer reported that as of this date, the Township has \$944,840.28 in the various funds for the Township, with a liability to the Road millage of \$24,760.87 and \$491.25 to a private road escrow account.

After discussion, Bonnville made a Motion to approve the contracts for the School Summer Tax Collection with the Fowlerville, Howell, and LESA, with a processing fee of \$3.00 per parcel, and to authorize the Supervisor & Treasurer to sign the contracts. Parker seconded the Motion. Roll Call vote, AA, MC.

Delmerico made a Motion to pay \$100,887.57 in Township bills, seconded by VanHouten. Roll Call vote, AA, MC. This amount includes \$69,667.61 for road work on Kane Road, \$11,901.60 for the monthly garbage pickup bill, and \$2,281.82 to the Township Planner.

Bonnville reported that the Township had 2 fire and 10 medical runs, by the Fire Authority, in the month of September. She also reported that while the Fire Authority had intended to burn down Ms. Ketchel's dome home, she had not arranged with DTE to disconnect the power to the house. The controlled burn will take place at a later date.

Parker reported that the zoning ordinance workshop with the planner had gone very well.

Allen reported that she is still working with the folks that were having an on-going garage sale on Cedar River Estates Rd., and has contacted a homeowner on Gregory Rd. concerning excessive unlicensed vehicles on the property. Allen was asked to look at the Krider property on Bull Run concerning junk vehicles on their property.

Ms. Allen then brought up with the Board a more formalized way for complaints to be

filed with her office. After discussion, Delmerico made a Motion that in order for a complaint to be acted upon, a complainant must either be a property owner, or resident of the Township, OR live or own property along one of the Township's borders. The Township Complaint Form must be filled out and signed by the complainant, and then filed with the Township Zoning Administrator. Bonnville seconded the Motion. AA, MC.

VanHouten reported that he is still contacting the interested parties, who will be making up the members of the Township Park Committee. He hopes to have it completed by the December Board meeting.

There was no response to the 2nd Call to the Public.

Delmerico made a Motion to Adjourn at 8:47PM; Parker seconded. AA, MC.
