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## 2023 Iosco Township Poverty Exemption Guidelines

**To be eligible, a person shall do all of the following on an annual basis:**

1. Be an owner of and occupy as a principal residence of the property in which an exemption is requested.
2. File a claim with the Assessor, Supervisor or Board of Review, accompanied by Federal and State income tax returns for all persons residing in the dwelling, including a property tax credit returns filed in the immediately preceding year and/or in the current year.
3. Produce a valid driver's license or other form of identification if requested.
4. Produce a deed, land contract or other evidence of ownership of the property for which an exemption is requested if requested.
5. Meet poverty income standards as defined and adopted by the Iosco Township Board.
  - a. Applicant's assets (excluding the principal residence) cannot exceed \$10,000
  - b. Income cannot exceed chart below

6. Any additional eligibility requirements as determined by the Township Board.
